

ENROLLING IN HEALTH INSURANCE

It's time to get covered. If you - or someone you know - needs health insurance, now is your chance to sign up for quality and affordable health insurance. Open enrollment only happens once each year. This year's open enrollment runs from November 1 through January 31. Don't miss your chance to get covered.

Financial help is available. 8 out of 10 people who enrolled in health coverage through Washington Healthplanfinder qualified for financial help to make their monthly premiums more affordable. If you choose not to buy health insurance this year, you may need to pay a fine on your taxes—\$695 per adult \$347.50 per child (up to \$2085 for a family), or 2.5% of family income, whichever is greater).

Compare and save. There are more plans than ever to choose from available through Washington Healthplanfinder. You might save money by switching to a new plan. **New for 2017**: **Dental insurance!**

Jan. 23, 2017	Deadline for coverage beginning February 1, 2017	
Jan. 31, 2017	Open enrollment ends	

Note: Enrollment in Apple Health (Medicaid) is year-round.

HOW DO I ENROLL?

To enroll in Apple Health (Medicaid) or qualified Health plans, you must set-up an account at www.washingtonhealthplanfinder.org

HOW DO I RENEW MY COVERAGE?

If you are enrolled in a qualified health plan through www.washingtonhealthplanfinder.org, you should have received a letter in October telling you what to do (if anything) to renew. Information on renewals is available at www.washingtonhealthplanfinder.org.

HOW DO I GET HELP?
