Pick up a self-swab test kit outside the Jefferson Healthcare Express Clinic entrance at the main hospital.

Use a home-test kit, sold at many pharmacies or online. Free kits for symptomatic people are at Jefferson County Public Health next to QFC in Port Townsend.

If Not Fully Vaccinated:

Quarantine at home for 10 days. **Test 3-5 days after exposure.**

To test: Use a home test kit. Kits sold at pharmacies or are available at no cost at Jefferson County Public Health at 615 Sheridan Street, Port Townsend, next to QFC. Or, visit a chain pharmacy offering free, drive-through testing.

If test is positive, call Jefferson County Public Health at **360-385-9400** so a COVID-19 nurse can assist you.

If Fully Vaccinated:

Wear a mask. Avoid crowded settings, medically vulnerable people, and air travel for 10 days following exposure. **Test 3-5 days after exposure and/or if symptoms develop.**

Traveling?

If you need a PCR test for travel, schedule an appointment with a chain pharmacy near you that offers that kind of testing (free).

OR

Call North Star Clinic in Port Townsend to schedule a testing appointment (cash).

Jefferson County Public Health and Jefferson Healthcare DO NOT offer travel testing.

JEFFERSON HEALTHCARE

Jefferson Healthcare COVID-19 Nurse Consult Line: **360-344-3094**. Nurses will follow up with patients within 24-48 hours to triage symptoms and schedule testing at the Jefferson Healthcare Drive-Through Testing Station on Sheridan Street in Port Townsend, open 7 days a week.

Individuals with mild COVID-like symptoms, who do not want medical help and only want to be tested for COVID-19 can pick up a self-swab test kit outside the Express Clinic entrance at the main hospital. [Click here for full details.](#)

In-car testing by appointment only. Clinic bills your insurance company, or accepts cash payment.

HOME TEST KITS

BinaxNow Self-Test: An antigen self-test is available for purchase. Retail cost is \$20-\$24. Available at many locations, including Safeway, QFC, CVS, Sam's Club, Walgreens, and Walmart. Also available online at Amazon, CVS, and Walmart. Free home test kits are available at Jefferson County Public Health for symptomatic individuals or those who had close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19.

[Pixel by LabCorp](#): A PCR self-test for home testing. LabCorp will send the test kit to your home via FedEx for a self-test that you ship back to LabCorp. Options for payment include: billing your health insurance; utilizing federal dollars for the uninsured; or pay with credit card.
