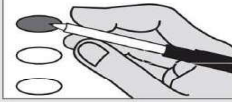


Sample Ballot - Jefferson County, WA Special Election Tuesday, February 9, 2021

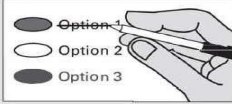
Instructions

Marking Your Ballot



Fill in the oval to the left of your choice with a dark pen. Vote for one. If you vote for more than one, that race or measure will not be counted. To vote for a candidate not on the ballot, print the name on the line and fill in the oval to the left.

Making A Correction



If you make a mistake, draw a line through the entire candidate's name or response. To vote for another candidate or response, fill in the oval to the left of your new selection.

Additional Information

Sign and date the voter's declaration on the return envelope.
For a replacement ballot, contact the Jefferson County Auditor's Office at (360) 385-9119. Deposit your ballot in a ballot drop box no later than 8:00 p.m. Election Day or mail. It must be postmarked on or before Election Day.

The Board of Directors of Sequim School District No. 323 adopted Resolution No. 02-2020/2021, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State of Washington:

Sequim School District No. 323 Proposition No. 2 Capital Levy to Improve School Facilities

The Board of Directors of Sequim School District No. 323 adopted Resolution No. 03B: 2020/2021, a proposition to finance improvements to school facilities. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, on all taxable property within the District, to modernize roofing; replace heating systems; upgrade networks; make sewer and water connections; modernize classrooms, gym and café flooring; install voice, access control and video surveillance systems; and replace the track, and stadium restrooms:

CHIMACUM SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 49
REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Chimacum School District No. 49 adopted Resolution No. 2020-10 concerning a proposition to finance educational operations and maintenance. This proposition authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, to support the District's educational programs, maintenance and operations all as provided in Resolution No. 2020-10:

QUEETS-CLEARWATER SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 20
EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS REPLACEMENT LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Queets-Clearwater School District No. 20 Adopted Resolution No. 11-17-20-03, concerning Proposition 1 to finance maintenance and operation expenses. Proposition 1, if approved, would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational maintenance and operational expenses:
