### COMMUNITY INCLUSION SERVICES

Community Inclusion services are individualized and provided in integrated community settings with other individuals without disabilities. The activities are based on Client interests and provide opportunities typically experienced by the general public of similar age in their local community, accessible by public transit or a reasonable commute from their home. One goal of the service is to support Clients to participate, contribute, volunteer and develop relationships with community members who are not paid staff.

**ESTIMATED NUMBER OF PEOPLE TO BE SERVED:** 10-25 People


