



## Additional Requirements for Registered Emergency Worker status with Jefferson County, WA



In addition to the other forms and testing, applicants for registration as Emergency Workers in Jefferson County with the Department of Emergency Management must present evidence they have completed the following Independent Study courses from FEMA. Emergency Workers will not be issued an ID until these courses are completed and certificates provided to the Volunteer Coordinator.

- ICS-100: Introduction to the Incident Command System
- ICS-200: ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents
- IS-700: An Introduction to the National Incident Management System
- IS-800: National Response Framework, An Introduction

These are online courses available on the FEMA website, if you do not have a FEMA Student ID, you will need to create one. This ID will be used in future FEMA trainings so it is advised that you save the number for future use: <https://training.fema.gov/nims/>
