<b>Project Description:</b> Printing 1000 9x4 in. double-sided rack cards that highlight respectful language when speaking about someone with a disability.				
<b>Benefits:</b>		People First language recognizes that people with disabilities are individuals with equal footing. Person first, disability second. <b>People First Language says what a person HAS not what a Person IS</b>		
<b>Objectives:</b>		The objective of this project are to create a rack card with an emphasis on respectful language about people with disabilities, and distribute these cards to businesses, medical offices, agencies, and service organizations initially.		
<b>Deliverables:</b>		2000 black and white 9x4 rack cards, printed and distributed throughout Jefferson County.		
<b>Success Criteria:</b>		People with disabilities are seen in a different light. We see people with disabilities as us vs. them.		
<b>Resources Required:</b>		2000, black & white 9x4 rack cards, printed and distributed throughout Jefferson County. (\$200.58 plus tax for camera ready (printed black on both sides and cut)		
<b>Potential Partners:</b>		Will identify agencies who have direct contact with public that could benefit from this information.		
<b>Potential Concerns</b>		People ignore the rack card because they think that disability doesn't have anything to do with them. Most people if they live long enough will experience some kind of disability.
