## **MEDICATION DISPOSAL**

**WHERE: Jefferson County Sheriff's Office  
79 Elkins Road; Port Hadlock**

**Free of charge**

**WHEN: Monday-Friday, By Appointment Only, (closed holidays) 360-385-3831**

- Bring drugs to the Sheriff's office; NO sharps or Vitamins accepted
- Drop off during business hours ONLY; do not leave discarded drugs after hours

## **VITAMINS and SUPPLEMENTS**

- Place with regular household trash
- **DO NOT** dispose of down any toilet, sink or drain

## **HYPODERMIC NEEDLES**

- Collect in an empty plastic soda bottle or commercial sharps container. When full, tighten and securely tape lid. Click here for [printable label](#)
- **DISPOSAL:**
  - Trash collection service subscribers: Place secured container inside trash can on top of household trash.
  - Trash self-haulers: Alert Scale Attendant (solid waste fees apply)
